

# Prince Nymph

**Hook:** Nymph Hook

1X or 2X Long #8-#16

Tiemco [3761](#), [5262](#)

Dai-Riki [060](#), [730](#)

**Thread:** [3/0](#) - [8/0](#) Black;

Size to Match Size of Hook

**Lead:** [Lead](#) Diameter should Match Wire of Hook

**Tail:** Brown Goose or [Turkey](#)

Biot (for photographic purposes done here in white)

**Rib:** [Gold Wire](#) or [Oval](#)

[Tinsel](#)

**Body:** [Peacock Herl](#)

**Beard:** [Brown Hackle](#)

**Wing:** White Goose or [Turkey](#) Biot

**1•** Create thread base. Wrap lead wire. Secure lead with thread.

**2•** Tie in tails. Brown biots should be installed on each side of hook. Tail length should equal hook gap.

**3•** Tie in gold wire for rib. Tie in 3 or 4 peacock herl at tail set position.

**4•** Wrap peacock herl forward and tie off leaving enough room at head for beard and wing. Counter wrap rib forward and tie off.

**5•** Tie in hackle. Make 3 to 4 wraps and secure with thread. Pull top and side barbules down and tie off to create a beard. Length of hackle fibers should be to hook point.

**6•** For wing, tie in 2 white biots divided. Length should be equal to body. Whip finish.
